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1. Price includes the use of both the indoor (80'x200') and the flexible outdoor (215'x280') arena. The outdoor arena includes the use of ground poles to make a 125' wide show pen alongside a 90' wide warm up pen, for example. No longeing of horses is permitted in the show arenas. Longeing is available in designated longeing areas.

2. Stalls will be clean upon arrival. Manure bunks are located near both barns for daily stall cleaning. We strip the stalls at the completion of the event. a) We currently provide 89 WVU owned stalls onsite; 48 in the multipurpose building, 29 in the WVU barn, and 12 under the overhang on the stall barn. b) You can rent additional tented portables and set up to 36 additional portable stalls onsite at your cost. We will charge you a reduced day fee for these stalls.

3. Each camper hookup includes water and electric. There are 24 total hookups on site.

4. Horses that haul-in and work out of their trailers must pay a grounds fee. This will help offset the cost of reseeding and grading areas tore up by horses trampling and/or pawing while tied on our grounds.

5. Vendors can park and work out of mobile units or set up in the bleacher area of the indoor arena. Food vendors must provide appropriate licenses and food handler's cards from the health department.

6. Ticketed events must remit 10% of total entry fees charged for public events. Events expecting attendance over 300 people must provide additional security and parking attendants at the renters cost.

7. Bags of pine bedding are available on site for purchase. Show management must coordinate the sales and delivery of bedding to the exhibitors. The show will be charged for what is used during the event.

8. Trail obstacles are available on site. Includes use of 10' poles, bridge, mailbox, and gate, and faux flowers/shrubbery.

9. Jump course is available on site. Includes the use of upright and winged standards, jump cups, 10'poles, and faux flowers/shrubbery.

10. Classrooms 1 & 2 seat 24 people each; separated by a moveable partition. The double classroom seats 48 with the partition opened. Classrooms are equipped with AV plug-ins for your laptop computer. Includes the use of the public restrooms inside the lobby of the education center.

11. The Outdoor Plaza is a hardscaped and landscaped space to host gatherings for up to 300 people. Includes the use of the public restrooms inside the lobby of the education center.

12. The grounds will be clean when you arrive. The public restrooms will be clean, trashcans will be empty with fresh bags, manure bunks will be empty, and parking lots will be clean and free of debris. It is the renter's responsibility to return the facility to us in the state they found it. *This includes putting away tables and chairs, removing all trash from the arenas, bleachers, bathrooms, concession stand, barns, and parking areas to the dumpsters provided on site.* All manure and hay on the grounds must be picked up and deposited in the manure bunks provided on site. Any cleaning required of our staff in excess of stripping stalls, sweeping/moping, and disinfecting the kitchen/bathrooms will be at an additional charge to the renter.
